Instructions for Students

This guide shows how to access a student account on the SCOPE student project website to update a student project.

1. Visit the website at <http://www.food-justice.net>
2. Click the “Request a new password” link in the lower left hand corner of your screen
3. On the password reset form enter your email address and then click the “Email new password” button
4. You will receive an email with a one-time login link
5. Click the one-time login link to access your account
 - Upon logging in, set your password - and then click Save
6. At the top of the page, click the “Edit Main Profile” link
 - Change your profile image as desired
 - Enter your first and last name
 - Fill in other text fields as you like
 - SET SCHOOL YEAR TO “2016-2017”
 - Click the Save button
7. In the upper left hand corner of the screen, click your username (right after the word “Hello”)
 - On this page, click the link to your project under the heading My Projects
Your project link name is initially set to “project.username.bt.fall2016”
8. Click the Edit button in the upper left hand corner of the screen to edit your project
 - Fill in the various fields for your project
 - Change the title of your project to your project’s title
 - Click on the gray tabs in the left sidebar to access all of the fields
 - Project

MAKE SURE YOUR YOUTUBE VIDEO IS SET TO PUBLIC NOT PRIVATE
 - Posters must be in JPEG format and less than 8MB in size

 - Set the appropriate categories in the right sidebar
 - When done, click the Save button


