## Instructions for Students

This guide shows how to access a student account on the new Food Justice website and to update a student project.

1. Visit the new website at <http://www.food-justice.net>
2. Click the “Request a new password” link form in the lower left hand corner of the website
3. On the password reset form enter your email address and then click “Email new password”
4. You will receive an email with a one-time login link
5. Click the one-time login link to access your account
  - Upon logging in, set your password - and then click Save
6. At the top of the page, click the “Edit Main Profile” link
  - Change your profile image as desired
  - Enter your first and last name
  - Fill in other text fields as you like
  - SET SCHOOL YEAR TO “2015-2016” if it is not already set to this value
  - Click the Save button
7. In the upper left hand corner of the screen, click your user name (right after the word “Hello”)
  - On this page, click the link to your project under the heading My Projects (the project link name is initially set to “username.2016”)
8. Click the Edit button in the upper left hand corner of the screen to edit your project
  - Fill in the various fields of your project
    - Change the title of your project to your project’s title
  - Click on the gray tabs in the left sidebar to access all of the fields
    - Project


